



Get Ready...



- Stay tuned to News Talk 850 WFTL for the most up-to-date information
- Follow all evacuation orders when issued by local officials
- If you intend to remain in your home secure windows and doors with approved shutters or plywood
- Do not operate generators or grills indoors
- Store propane and gasoline safely
- Refrain from using candles for light, use flashlights and/or battery powered lanterns instead
- Withdraw cash before the storm
- Fill your vehicle's fuel tank before the storm arrives
- Store your important documents in plastic bags or boxes
- Keep your ID on you at all times

- **Tropical Storm Watch**- Tropical storm conditions are possible within 48 hours
- **Tropical Storm Warning**- Tropical storm conditions are possible within 36 hours
- **Hurricane Watch**- Hurricane conditions are possible within 48 hours
- **Hurricane Warning**- Hurricane conditions are possible within 36 hours

Category 1 Hurricane

- Winds of 74-95 MPH

Category 2 Hurricane

- Winds of 96-110 MPH

Category 3 Hurricane

- Winds of 111-129 MPH

Category 4 Hurricane

- Winds of 130-156 MPH

Category 5 Hurricane

- Winds of 157+ MPH

Food & Water

- 7 Day Supply of:
- Non-perishable canned goods
 - Non-perishable dry goods
 - Water; 1 gallon per person, per day

- Picnic supplies
- Ice
- Cooler(s)
- Camping stove
- Charcoal
- Propane

Medical Supplies

- 2 week supply of prescription medicines
- First aid kit

Tools

- Hammer
- Pliers

- Ax or hatchet
- Nails & screws
- Portable generator
- Yard tools
- Fuel
- Plastic tarps
